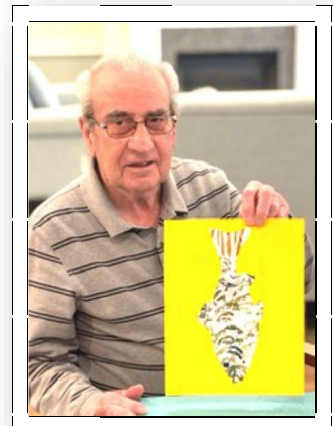
Notes from Activities

These mid- to late-summer stunners are named after the Greek word for "star." Asters come in a beautiful range of colors, including pink, purple, blue, and red, with a yellow or black center.
